

COML - All-Hazards Type III Communications Unit Leader (COML)

This course helps participants establish the essential core competencies required for performing the duties of the Communications Unit Leader (COML) in an all-hazards incident. This course addresses all responsibilities appropriate to a COML operating in a local- or State-level All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). These responsibilities include the collection, processing, and dissemination as needed to facilitate Operations of Command, General Staff, and Unit Leaders within the confines of a Type 3 AHIMT. The course is an instructor-led training that supports learning through discussion, lecture, and active participation in multiple exercises. By requiring participants to bring a COML Kit to the instruction, the course provides a realistic, hands-on approach to mastering the skills of a COML.

Prerequisites:

ICS-300, *Intermediate Incident Command System (ICS) for Expanding Incidents*;
IS-100.b, *Introduction to the Incident Command System (ICS), ICS-100*;
IS-200.b, *Incident Command System (ICS) for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents*,
ICS-200;
and IS-700.a, *National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction*.
